NATIVE PLANT GUIDE 2017

A Native Garden For Every Place

Native plants in the landscape are water-efficient and pollinator-friendly alternatives to traditional garden perennials. They can provide season-long beauty and interest. However, some native plants can be bullies in the garden. Carefully planned species selection will ensure the success of your new wildflower area. If you prefer a more formal style, try clump-forming, less prolific species. Seek out plants that are flop-proof, will stay where you planted them, and have an agreeable shape at maturity. “Well-behaved” prairie plants are just as pollinator and eco-friendly as their unruly cousins, with less mess. Some of our favorites are October Skies aster (*A. oblongifolius*), yarrow (*Achillea* sp.), butterfly milkweed (*Asclepias tuberosa*) and wild indigo (*Baptisia australis*).

Here is a design for a formal style shade garden using native plants. A more informal, ‘wildscape’ design for full sun can be found on the back of this guide.

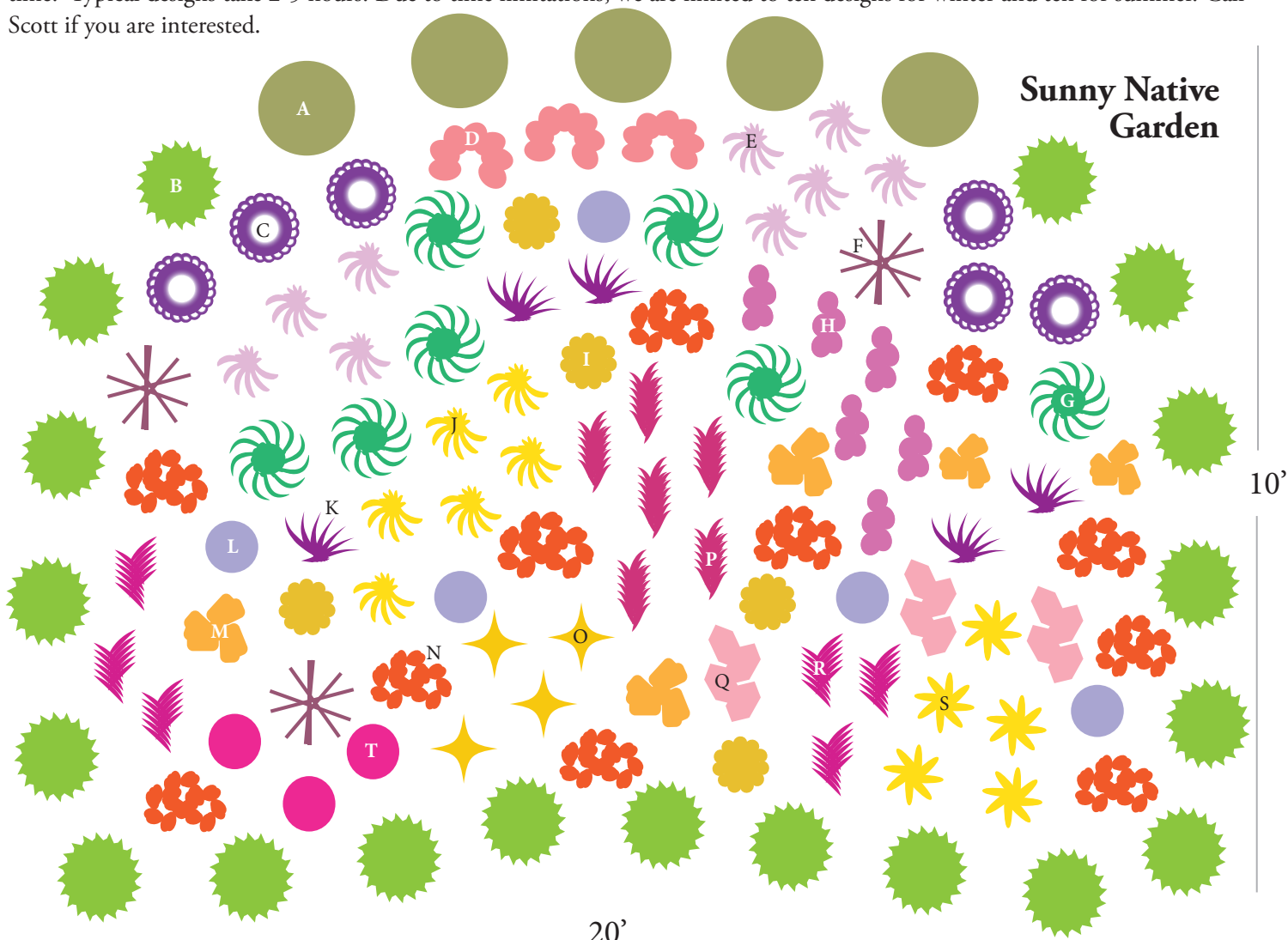

Planting on the Wild Side

If you want a garden that embodies the true wildness of the prairie, don't shy away from self-seeding, tough-as-nails plants. Choose species that are adapted to our region, provide year-long interest and don't need much fuss. A bushy, vibrant habitat around a pond edge or a no-mow native area will attract pollinators and benefit wildlife. A diverse mix of species that will fill in and fight for space will be appropriate in a wild area; include common milkweed (*A. syriaca*), goldenrod (*Solidago* sp.), New England aster (*A. novae-angliae*) and Indian grass (*Sorghastrum nutans*). Also, consider *Silphium* sp., *Monarda* sp., *Liatris pycnostachya*, *Liatris aspera*, *Panicum virgatum*, *Rudbeckia triloba*, *Verbena hastata*, *Verbena stricta*, and *Ratibida* sp.

Below is a landscape design that is diverse and beautiful, with grassy borders to frame and give it structure. This design would look great in most sunny locations.
