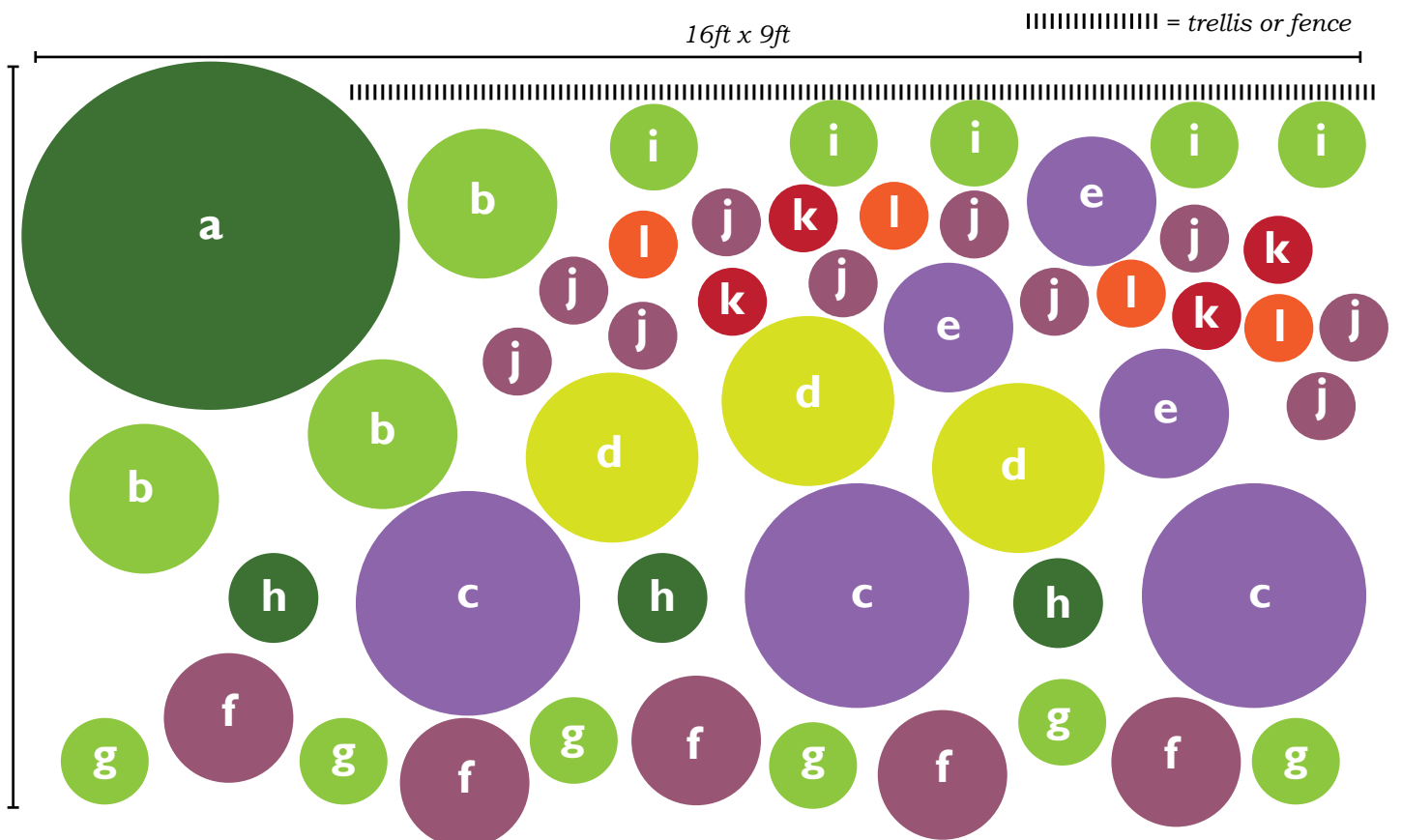
COMBINING NATIVES AND EDIBLES

Growing your own produce is an easy way to cut down food's massive carbon footprint and get more fruits and vegetables in your diet. But many people don't have the yard space for a production garden *and* landscaping.

Perhaps it is time to bring kitchen gardens back into fashion — mixing food plants and aesthetically pleasing design. In Renaissance era France these were called potagers; in 1500s Scotland, kailyards. Diverse plantings of flowers, shrubs, herbs and vegetable crops ensured the kitchen garden supplied food and beauty throughout the growing season. Vegetables don't have to grow in rows!

I hope you will be inspired by the design below. This garden will attract pollinators, add color, and provide bushels of homegrown goodies for your summer dinner parties. The native plants seen here will be available at FloraKansas. Ask your local extension office for their recommendations on vegetable varieties.



- a. *Cephalanthus*, button bush 'Sugar Shack'
- b. hot or sweet peppers
- c. *Aster oblongifolius*, 'October Skies'
- d. *Zizia aptera*, golden alexander

- e. *Tradescantia ohiensis*, spiderwort
- f. purple cabbage or kale
- g. *Sporobolus heterolepis*, prairie dropseed
- h. oregano and/or thyme

- i. beans or peas
- j. *Liatris spicata*, blazing star
- k. beets
- l. carrots

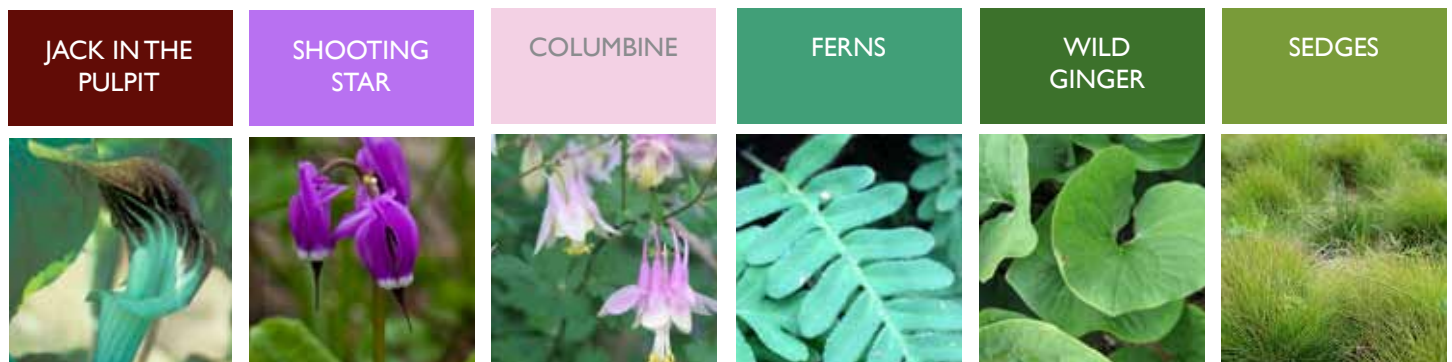

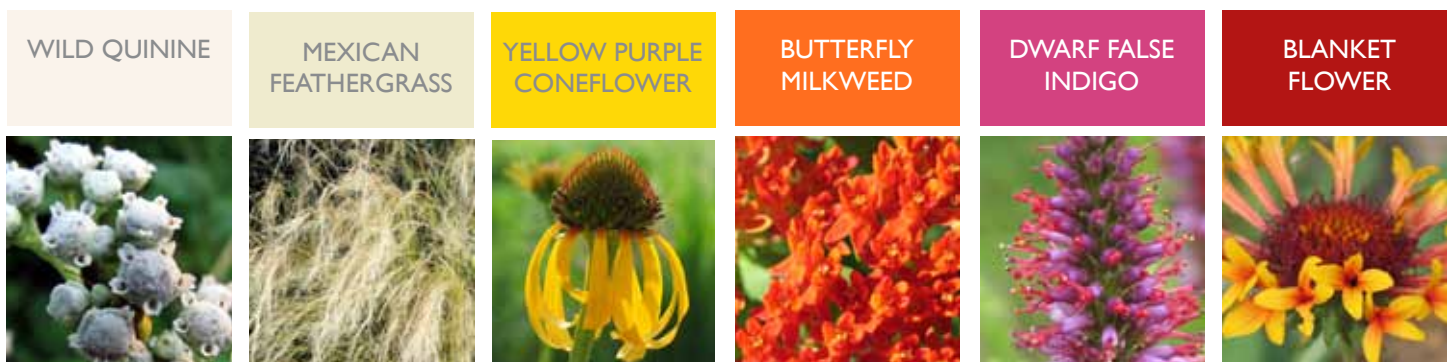
